G1VAR Unit 1 Experiences

The focus for this unit is experiences. Students develop artworks based on their lives /personal identity and experiences, observations of the immediate environment, events of their world. They participate in selected art experiences aimed at developing a sense of observation. Students discover ways to compile and record their experiences through a range of art activities and projects that promote a fundamental understanding of visual language. They use experiences to develop appreciation of the visual arts in their everyday lives. Students acquire various skills using processes of experimentation and discovery in a visual format. Imaginative visual inquiry, including aspects of family life, social activities, communal occasions and other shared activities. Ample scope for free, imaginative interpretation and experimentation with materials is provided.
