Elective: *The USA between the wars 1918–1941.*

The unit will focus on the experiences of people in the USA and how it has helped to define the modern world. Students learn about the values, beliefs, traditions and various forces for continuity and change. The crucial changes which resulted in the transformation of USA over the period and the challenges that this has posed to its society and government will be explored.

Unit 4 Historical trends and movements

Elective: *Nazism in Germany 1918 - 1945.*

The unit will focus on the interesting phenomenon of the rise of Nazi Germany, the magnetic personality of Adolf Hitler and the coming of war. The unit investigates the ways in which individuals, groups and institutions have challenged existing political structures, accepted social organisation, and prevailing economic models, to transform societies
